AMENDMENT BYLAW No. 1907, 2020

**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION BYLAW NO. 34 TO ADD TICKET
INFORMATIONS FOR THE BUSINESS REGULATION (COVID-19) BYLAW No. 1907, 2020**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Langford deems it expedient to provide for an amendment to the Ticket Information Bylaw No. 34, 1993;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Langford enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

This bylaw may be cited as the "Ticket Information Bylaw No. 34, 1993 Amendment Bylaw No. 1907, 2020."

2. SEVERABILITY

If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of this bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

3. REPEAL

This bylaw is repealed on the later of the repeal of the public health emergency declared under the *Public Health Act* on March 17, 2020 or the state of emergency initially declared under the *Emergency Program Act* on March 18, 2020.

4. BYLAW AMENDMENTS

(a) Ticket Information Bylaw No. 34, 2005 is amended by adding to the end of Schedule 1 the following:
